Year 6
Term 4, 2024

English

Listening & Speaking

- Students share, develop, explain and elaborate on ideas from a literary text for a particular purpose and audience.

Reading & Viewing

- Students read, view and comprehend songs and poems

Writing & Creating

- Students write a new school song which reflects the time and culture of the school and can be used on school assembly.

Structured Literacy

- Student participate in explicit daily lessons to develop handwriting, spelling, dictation, and vocabulary.

Maths

Number and Algebra

- Solve problems involving fractions, decimals and percentages of a quantity.
- Apply computational approaches to develop algorithms that use rules to generate numbers.
- Recognise and use rules that generate growing number patterns.

Probability

- Describe and compare probabilities numerically.
- Observe and compare long-run frequencies in repeated chance experiments and simulations.

Structured Numeracy

- Participate in explicit daily lessons to develop fluency, reasoning, problem-solving skills, flexible thinking and a positive disposition towards Maths.

Humanities & Social Sciences

Students will:

- explore the question, 'How do people and environments influence one another?'

Science

Students will:

- investigate structural and behavioural adaptations of animals and plants.

The Arts - Music

Students will:

- explore music written for Ukulele.
- read rhythm, pitch and symbols specific to uke music.
- compose in compound time and explore music written for Keyboard
- listen to and explore changes to Art Music written for keyboard

Health & Physical Education

- analyse and rehearse protective behaviours and help-seeking strategies for online and offline
- describe strategies for seeking, giving or denying consent.
