## English

### Listening & Speaking

- Interact with others, listen to and express an opinion.

### Reading & Viewing

- Engage with fiction and non-fiction texts on celebrations and commemorations from different countries.

### Writing & Creating

### Structured Literacy

### Number

- Order numbers beyond 10 000

### Space & Statistics

- Interpret and create two-dimensional representations of familiar environments.
- Conduct guided statistical investigations with data and interpret the results
- Record, represent and compare collected data

### Structured Numeracy

- Participate in explicit daily lessons to develop fluency, reasoning, problem-solving skills, flexible thinking and a positive disposition towards Maths.

## Humanities & Social Sciences

### Students will:

- Identify the importance of different celebrations and commemorations for different groups.
- Share understandings of a celebration with a familiar audience.

## Science

### Students will:

- They identify sources of heat energy and examples of heat transfer and explain changes in the temperature of objects.
- Investigate how well heat is transferred by different types of materials such as metals, plastics and ceramics and identifying how materials are used to keep things hot and cold

## Health & Physical Education

### Movement

- Refine throwing, catching, and balancing skills and use movement concepts to solve challenges.

### Health

- Develop strategies for safe and respectful online interactions.
