English

Reading & Viewing

Students will:

- participate in shared reading, viewing and comprehending texts.

Writing & Creating

Students will:

- create a short, written text to retell a familiar story.

Speaking & Listening

Students will:

- share about a favourite character (Y1) and the character's traits (Y2)

Structured Literacy

Students will:

- participate in explicit daily lessons to develop phonemic awareness, oral language, word decoding (reading), handwriting, and vocabulary.

HASS

Students will:

- Identify continuity and change in people's daily lives.

Visual Arts

Students will:

- learn to use BeeBots.
- be introduced to basic coding.

Health & Physical Education

Students will:

- explore personal qualities and investigate personal identities.
- develop an awareness of emotions.
- manage and develop respectful relationships.

Maths

Year 1

Students will:

- give and follow directions to move people and objects within a space
- collect and record categorical data, create one-to-one displays, and compare and discuss the data using frequencies.

Year 2

Students will:

- locate and identify positions of features in two-dimensional representations and move position by following directions and pathways
- use a range of methods to collect, record, represent and interpret categorical data in response to questions

Structured Numeracy

Students will:

- participate in explicit daily lessons to develop number sense and a positive disposition towards Maths.

Science

Students will:

- identify ways to change materials without changing their material composition.
- compare observations with others and identify if their investigation was fair

The Arts – Music

Students will:

- explore dynamics, rhythm, pitch, beat and tempo.
- listen to and discuss music from a different era and music for orchestra
- Explore instruments of the orchestra.
- sing, play, compose and respond.
