English

Listening & Speaking

- Share ideas about factual texts in literary discussions.

Reading & Viewing

- Engage with non-fiction and fiction texts on the animals and protection of the Great Barrier Reef.

Writing & Creating

- Write an information report on a reef animal.

Structured Literacy

- Participate in explicit daily lessons to develop handwriting, spelling, dictation, and vocabulary.

Maths

Number & Algebra

- Partition, rearrange & regroup numbers
- Add and subtract up to 3-digit numbers
- Make connections between addition and subtraction
- Consolidate multiplication facts for 2, 5 and 10.

Measurement & Space

- Measuring length, mass and capacity,
- Making and classifying three-dimensional objects
- Representing money values in different ways

Structured Numeracy

- Participate in explicit daily lessons to develop fluency, reasoning, problem-solving skills, flexible thinking and a positive disposition towards Maths.

Humanities & Social Sciences

Students will:

- Develop knowledge and understanding about the significance of events, symbols and emblems in representing Australia's identity and diversity.

The Arts - Music

Students will:

- Analyse fold songs
- Read and write music
- Perform their own composition with boom whackers

The Arts – Visual Arts

Students will:

- Explore through the manipulation of visual language to represent human connections to imagined environments inspired by real places.

Students will

- Compare characteristics of living and non-living things and examine the differences between the life cycles of plants and animals.

Students will:

- Develop the movement skills of running, jumping and throwing.
- Perform a range of athletic movements in preparation for the Track & Field Carnival.
