



ACADEMIC & SPORTING REPRESENTATIVE CONTRIBUTION POLICY

The Ferry Hills State School P&C Association, at its discretion shall financially assist students of Ferry Hills State School who have been chosen to represent their school in primary school approved sports or academic activities at either state or national competitions. This assistance is dependent upon their involvement in their school and their contribution to the Ferry Hills State School P&C Association through participation in fundraising activities, personal assistance and financial contribution. An amount of 20% of the cost of participation (excluding travel and accommodation expenses) to a maximum of \$200 will be made available to approved applicants. Documentation setting out the costs involved must be attached to the application.

The following conditions apply:

- All applications to be lodged online at https://forms.office.com/Pages/ResponsePage.aspx?id=0kw_mYiQiYkeIZnNU7YZzfSwAgOyajh5KqFv_BfbBBRUNTFEMVR_ESFISNTZERUxYMFVEOUxXMVJLWi4u by 31st October each year.
- Applications will be submitted to the P&C meeting held in November each year for approval.
- Correspondence and payment to all successful applicants will be prepared as soon as possible after the November meeting each year.
- The amount allocated in the budget each year will be distributed amongst the successful applicants with a maximum of \$200 per student. The distribution of funds will be made based upon discussions held and determinations made at the November P&C meeting each year. The amount allocated to each applicant will be dependent upon the number of applications received and the amount allocated in the P&C budget.
- All applicants must have competed or participated at a recognised State or National competition. Participation at a local or district level does not qualify for any P&C contribution. This includes district sports carnivals, district swimming carnivals, Intermediate and Advanced Music Camps and district choir workshops. To qualify as a state or national competition participant, students must be a member of a regional (Met North) or state team (QLD).

Review

This policy will be reviewed annually at the P&C Annual General Meeting.
